Kids on Computers (www.kidsoncomputers.org), a charitable organization based in the United States, has provided this computer and installed the Ubermix operating system. Ubermix (www.ubermix.org) is an all-free, specially built, Linux-based operating system designed from the ground up with the needs of education in mind. Kids on Computers has customized the Ubermix 2.1L installation image to include **language packs** (French and Arabic) and **additional applications** (Edubuntu Suite) for use in Morocco.

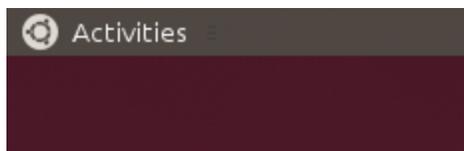
Start / Login

Ubermix is designed to be used without requiring a login. After starting the computer, there should not be a prompt for login information. However, if you are ever prompted, try these:

Username: "user" Password: "password"
or Username: "koc" Password: "koc"

Activities

Click on the Activities button in the upper right corner of the screen.

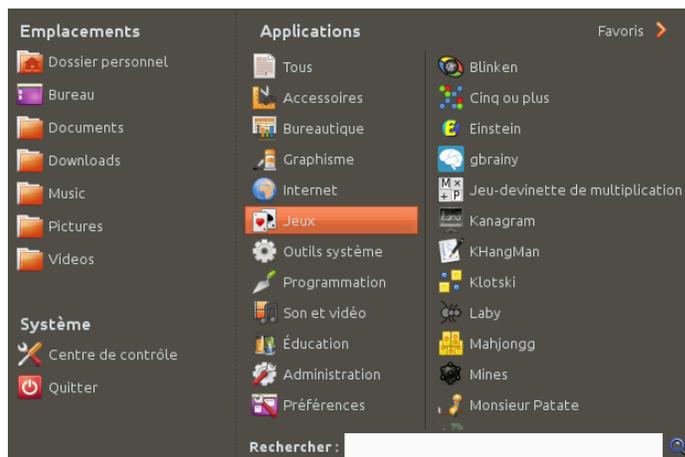


To open a file, choose a folder in the left column.

To start a program, choose a category in the middle column, then choose a program in the right column. You can also switch between "Favorites" and "All Applications".

To access the Internet or Local Area Network Media Server, use **Chrome**.

To shutdown or restart the computer, choose the "Quit" menu option.

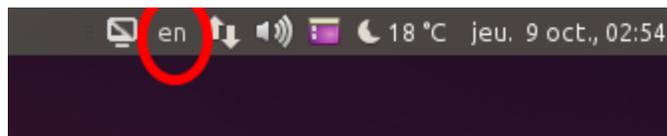


Chrome:



Changing Keyboard Layout

To type French or Arabic characters using an English keyboard, change the keyboard layout. Choose the menu option at the upper right of the screen. Right-click for more options or to view the keyboard layout.



Changing Languages

Language packs (French and Arabic) have been installed, and can be activated using these steps. If text for an application has not been fully translated, it may appear as English.

- Activities
- Control Center
- Language Support
- Select and drag the desired language to the top
- Click "Apply System Wide"
- Reboot
